

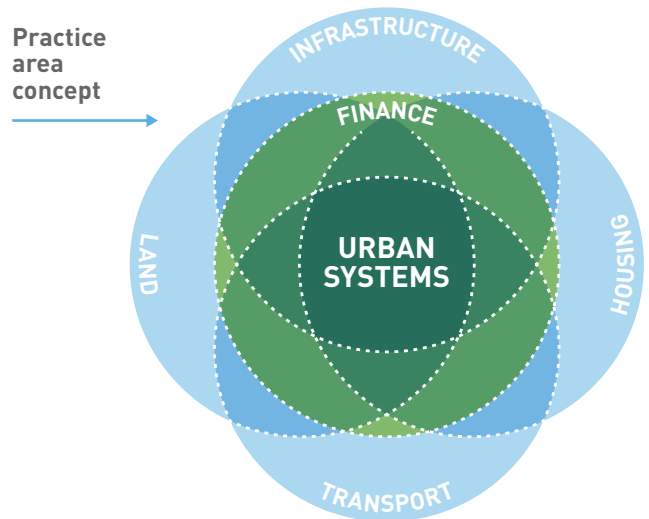

Our interest is in how cities function to facilitate the flow of people and resources to benefit the economy and the quality of life for citizens. Given the vast social inequalities that exist in South Africa, urban systems need to ensure basic service provision and shelter for all residents, particularly the poor. In the African context of increased urbanization, government needs to be able to respond to urbanization through the provision of services and housing, while balancing investments in existing assets and infrastructure that supports economic growth, all the while protecting the environment.

We provide consulting services around a full suite of public sector functions to clients that are tasked with integrating these functions, as well as those that have a larger policy perspective.

We undertake research, policy development, and financial analysis around housing, land, spatial planning, infrastructure services, public transport, public services, and environmental sustainability.
