




To enable and strengthen the practical implementation of Monitoring and Evaluation in and across the City of Johannesburg (CoJ).

In line with the requirements of the City of Johannesburg's Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) Framework, 2012, the assignment developed a practical M&E Handbook to support the implementation of its Framework. The M&E Handbook is intended as a practical resource reinforcing the City's outcomes-based approach to programming and performance management, enabling the City to become increasingly results-oriented.

Review of secondary data on key organisational strategies and plans relevant to the City's performance planning, monitoring, evaluation and reporting processes; and primary data on the actual practice of these processes in the City. Triangulation of primary data, secondary information reviewed, and good practice guidelines on outcomes-based M&E.

Located within and complementary to existing planning, performance management and M&E legislation, programmes, guidelines, policies and procedures, the Handbook is a guide with practical tools on 'how to' go about strengthening and mainstreaming results-oriented planning, monitoring and evaluation within the City's core administration and across its municipal entities.
